'MUST DO' TASKS

Reading

We will continue to change our reading books weekly, after our reading practise sessions. Please listen to your child read their book which they should be able to do independently. If they can't read a word, read it to them and talk about the book with them when they have read it.

There is also a library book for you to share with your child. Please share this with them by reading it to them.

This half term please share as many fairy tales with your child as you can. Talk to them about the story.

Maths

Practise counting in 2s, 5s and 10s with your child in every day.

When doing this practise 'dual counting'
eg. 0, 10, 20, 30 40 etc...

No tens, 2 tens, 3 tens, 4 tens....

Practise counting backwards from 100.

Count out a number of objects from around the house and group them into tens. How many groups of ten can you make up to 100? (Use Lego, pasta pieces, smarties, beads etc...)

Count out ten 1p coins and exchange them for a 10p coin. Discuss the value of the 10p coin.

Please practise spellings as often as you can with your child.

Challenge 1 Write them in different colours.

Challenge 2 Write them with your eyes closed.

Challenge 3 Try putting them in a sentence.

Can you write a question or exclamation sentence using your spelling words?

Challenge 1

Harvest Cooking

Try baking some bread!

Challenge 2

This Half Term's Maths Challenge

Pop to the shops!

Save up 10p and 1p coins.

When you have a good amount of these coins, practise making amounts up to £1.00 with these coins (eg...36p would be 3 x 10p and 6 x 1p). As a reward for their hard work, pop to the shops with your child. Allow them to choose something they would like to buy using their saved 10p and 1p coins.



Challenge 3

Science Walk

Go on a walk together and look for things that are alive, have never been alive, or were once alive and aren't anymore (eg...dead leaves on the floor, a piece of wooden play equipment that used to be a tree etc...).
