Reading

Answer these questions: Who is your favourite character? What is your favourite part in the story? What happens at the end of the story? Can you spot any of your tricky words in your book?

Maths

Practise counting objects saying one number for each object. You could do this when getting the cutlery out for dinner, counting how many sweets you have in a packet or how many cars you can see on the road.



Spelling/phonics

Continue to practise your sounds. You will find a new set each week in your home learning book.

Play sound detective with your grown up.

Which of these sounds can you spot around Marchwood?

Which sounds can you spot when sharing a book?
