Reading

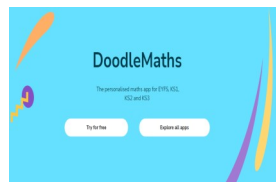
We will continue to change our reading books weekly, after our reading practise sessions. Please listen to your child read their book which they should be able to do independently. If they can't read a word, read it to them and talk about the book with them when they have read it.

There is also a library book for you to share with your child. Please share this with them by reading it to them.

Maths

Practise counting with your child in everyday situations, counting in 1s forwards and backwards to 100 from any number. Also counting in 2s forwards and back to 20 and 10s forwards and back to 100.

Weekly Spellings: Practise these at home. Ideas can be found in their spelling books. Spelling tests are on a Monday.

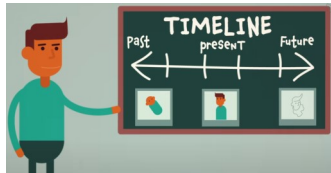

Life History Timelines

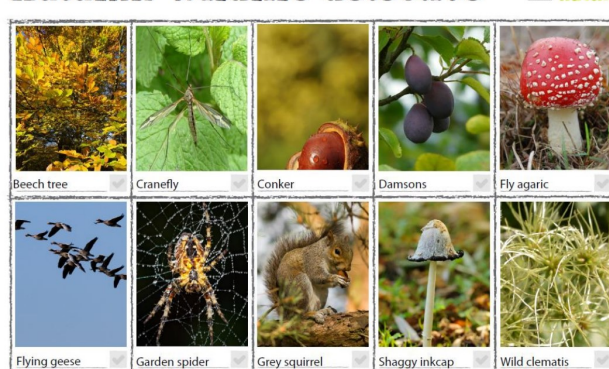
Throughout the school year we are looking at different events through history. We have talked about past events and have looked at timelines. Have a go at making a timeline of your life, this link will help...
