Reading

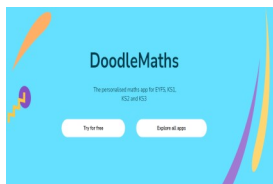
We will change our reading books weekly, after our reading practise sessions. Please listen to your child read their book which they should be able to do independently. If they can't read a word, read it to them and talk about the book with them when they have read it.

There is also a library book for you to share with your child. Please share this with them by reading it to them.

Maths

Practise counting with your child in everyday situations, counting in 1s forwards and backwards to 50 from any number. Also counting in 2s forwards and back to 20.

Use your child's log in to complete some of the activities on Doodle Maths.

'CAN DO' CHALLENGES

Challenge 1

Harvest Cooking

Try cooking with some autumnal fruit and vegetables.

Maybe an apple and blackberry crumble, pumpkin soup, apple cake or pie?

Take some photos of your creations, or even better bring us in a little sample!



Challenge 2

This Half Term's Maths Game - Secret Numbers

Write the numbers 0 to 20 on a sheet of paper.

Ask your child secretly to choose a number on the paper.

Then some questions to find out what the secret number is, e.g. Is it less than 10? Is it between 10 and 20? Does it have a 5 in it?

They may answer only yes or no.

For an easier game, use numbers up to 10.

For a harder game, use only 5 questions, or use bigger numbers.



Challenge 3

Harvest Art

Go on a walk in the forest and collect some fallen leaves, conkers or acorns. Make a picture with what you have found.

Don't forget to take some pictures of your creations.
