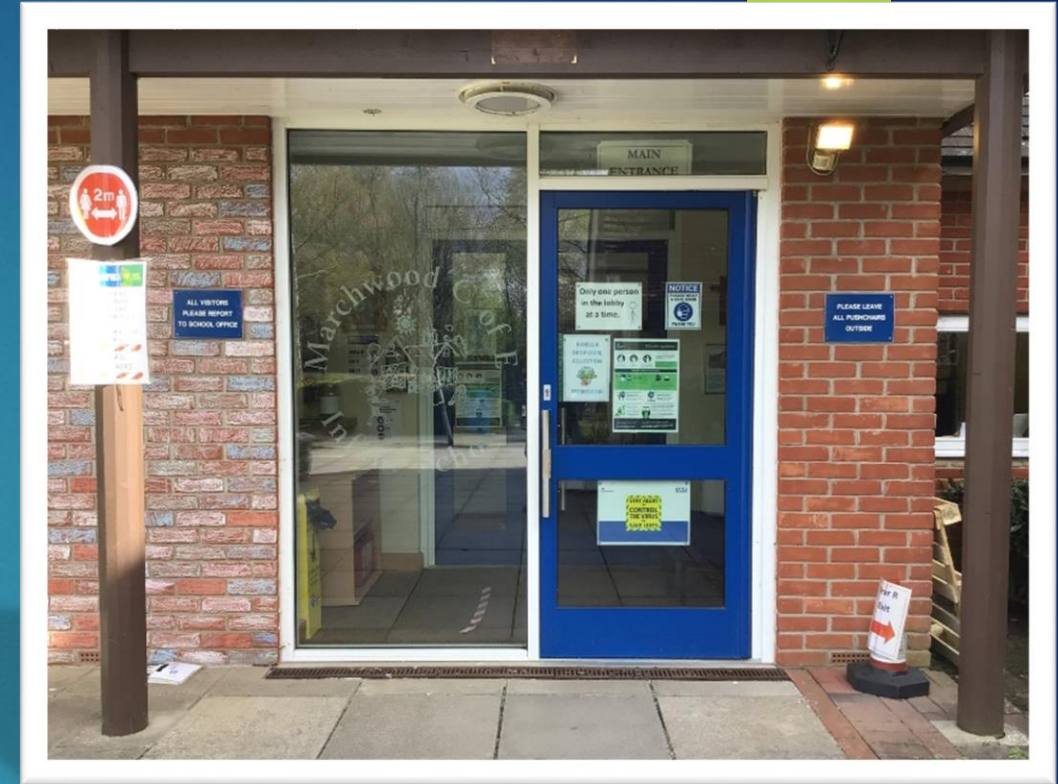


My new school

When you come to school you will wear school uniform.

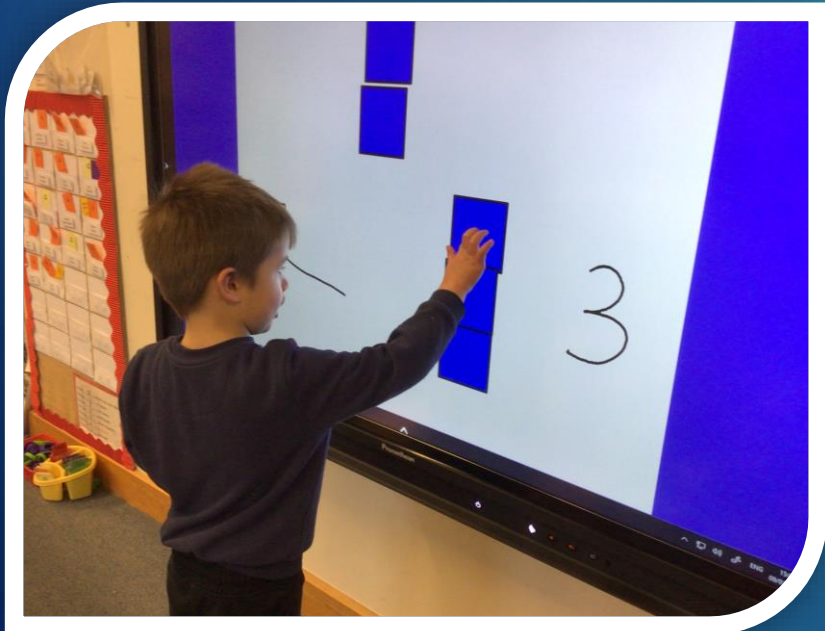
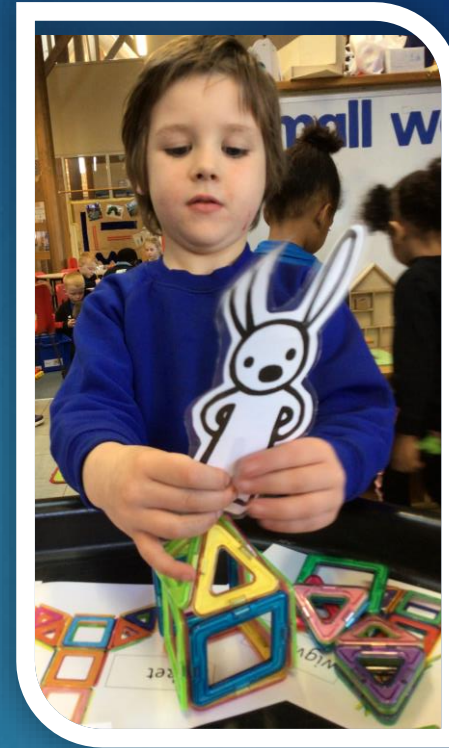
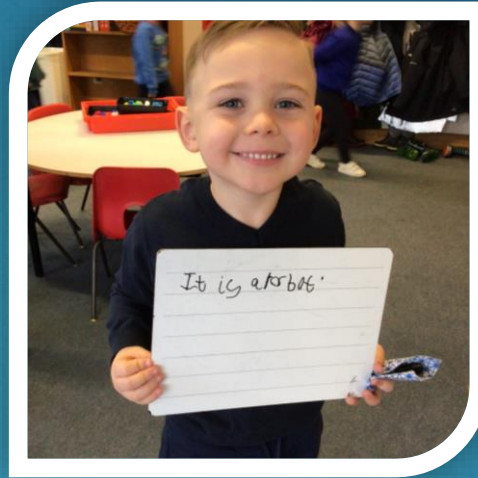
On P.E. days you will wear your P.E. kit to school.

You may have milk and vegetables or fruit like a carrot or a banana.



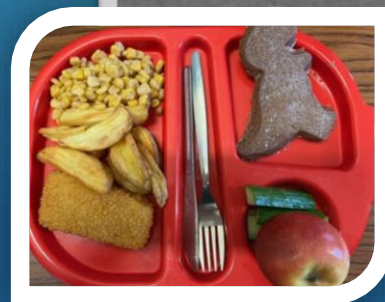
You can drink water from your water bottle whenever you want.
